3 Options for Yard Waste Collection

Each must weigh 40 pounds or less

- Biodegradable paper yard waste bags
- Reusable container made of metal or rigid plastic, equipped with handles, and marked with a large "X" on all sides of the container
- Bundled branches tied securely with twine



County issued recycling carts, plastic bags, and non-rigid, lightweight containers, including fabric, plastic, collapsible mesh, or other reusable bags are **NOT** an acceptable container for yard waste collection.

ACCEPTED as YARD WASTE

- Leaves, garden waste, grass clippings, weeds, and prunings
- Branches (less than 4' long and 4" in diameter, tied into bundles weighing less than 40 pounds)



NOT ACCEPTED as YARD WASTE

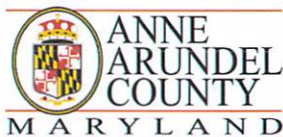
- Tree stumps
- Sawdust, dirt, or sod
- Food waste
- Lumber, treated wood, pallets
- Bamboo
- Gumballs (Sweetgum seed pods)
- Pet Waste
- Flower pots or trays



FROM LEAVES TO FOOD SCRAPS: GET THE DIRT ON COMPOSTING
