Street Seal Coating/ Restriping: Thanks to everyone for the support. Only 1 car needed to be relocated. Looks great!

Elections: Board of Director elections occur at the annual meeting scheduled for 9/10/2026. There are 2 board members up for reelection and 1 open seat. Every decision The Board of Directors makes affects us all. Please consider being a member.

Ballots will be mailed in the next couple of days. Beginning August 26, a locked ballot box will be placed on the steps of 1222 Brunswick Ct. The ballots MUST be placed in the Ballot box or 1222 mailbox otherwise they will not be counted. Do not return ballots to Sentry. Proxies may be returned to Sentry with the enclosed envelope. The ballots will be counted at the Sept 11 meeting. Please Vote.

Community Picnic: A community picnic is being planned for Sunday, September 13. The HOA will provide burgers, dogs, buns, and soda. Attendees can provide extras like desserts, salads, and chips.

Vehicle Registration: The board has voted to make it mandatory for all residents to register their vehicles with Sentry by January 1. This allows identification of vehicles that are illegally parked.

Visitor Parking: The Board has received complaints from neighbors concerning non-residents and residents parking in visitor spots. Who can park in Visitor Parking and for how long continues to be a problem. As noted above, vehicle registration with Sentry will aid in identifying if the vehicle belongs to a resident. In addition, the Board is considering:

- Limiting residents parking in Visitor spots to 3 consecutive days and a total of 7 days/mo.
- Limiting the number of vehicles a resident can park in Visitor spots at any one time.
- Charging residents \$100/mo.

- Leave everything as it is.

The Board needs input from the community.

Recycling: Please review the County recycling guidelines that can be found on:

www.tanglewood2.com. There have been recent issues where recycling hasn't been picked up or in one instance trash was removed from the recycling truck after it was noted that it was mixed waste after it had been dumped in the truck.
